**Walk-In Entries Will Be Accepted 2 Hours Prior To Any Shift On
Space Available Basis, First Come, First Served!**

ELIGIBILITY: This tournament shall be governed by USBC rules. Entrants in this tournament must be current members of the Augusta USBC Bowling association or the Augusta USBC Women's Bowling Association. **USBC Rule 13** regarding parental consent does apply. A parental consent form must be attached to your entry form, if applicable.

CLOSING DATE: Submit entries by midnight October 30, 2011. There will be no refunding of fees once an entry has been accepted. **Entries should postmarked or dropped in the Augusta USBCBA/WBA boxes at the bowling centers by 10/30/11.**

Walk-in entries 2 hours prior to any shift will be accepted on a space available basis.

TEAM EVENT: Teams shall be composed of 4 persons, 2 men and 2 women, and will bowl 3 games on one pair of lanes. No team or individual may bowl more than two (2) times. No more than two players on one team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings.

DOUBLES EVENT: A doubles team shall be composed of 1 man and 1 woman and will bowl 3 games on one pair of lanes. Entrants are allowed with different partners, but no person may bowl more than 2 times.

HANDICAP: Handicap shall be 100% of the difference between a bowler's average and 210. There will be no limit on handicap.

AVERAGES: Entrants will use their highest 2010-11 Augusta USBCBA/WBA yearbook average. Entrants without a 2010-11 average will use their highest current Augusta winter average of 21 games or more as of November 1, 2011. **(Verified in writing and signed by the league secretary).** All other entrants must bowl scratch. **Rule 319C and Rule 319D will apply in its entirety for possible re-rating.**

AVERAGE VERIFICATION: All bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average and will be subject to **USBC Rule 319A (2&3). The 10-Pin Rule is in effect.** Average corrections can be made up to the end of the first game of a series or if an extension of time has been granted in writing by Tournament Management before the end of the first game of the series, within 48 hours of the end of series **(USBC Rule 319A) (#4).**

FEES AND PRIZES: Entry fees will be \$19.00 per person, per event, \$8.00 lineage, \$9.00 prize fund and \$2.00 expense fee. Prize monies will be returned 100%. **The number of prizes paid in each event will be determined on a ratio of at least one prize for every ten entries in that event.** The Tournament Director will verify all averages prior to awarding prizes

SCHEDULING: Preference in dates and times will be given in order of receipt of entry. Any changes in scheduling will be made at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

LINE-UP AND SUBSTITUTES: No change in lineup will be allowed, although substitutions will be permitted. Substitutions should be made one hour prior to the scheduled bowling time.

SCORE SHEETS: The tournament recap sheet will be the official score sheet. Scores will be verified from the automatic scorer printouts. Team captains and doubles participants must sign the official score sheets.

ERRORS, CLAIMS, AND PROTESTS: Scoring errors to be corrected must be reported within 48 hours after the games are bowled. Claims for prize money must be made within 15 days after receipt of prize list. All claims must be made in writing to the Tournament Director. Any protests affecting eligibility or playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director or to USBC before prize payments are made **(USBC Rule 329).** In the event of a conflict between USBC rules and local tournament rules, the stricter rule shall apply.

TARDY PLAYERS: If a bowler is late, a score of zero will be given for each framed missed. All bowlers **MUST** be up and ready to bowl when it is their turn, if not a score of zero (0) will be given for that frame.

LOST SCORES: Scores lost due to power failure shall be rebowled.

SPECIAL PRIZES: Contingent upon funding, special awards may be given to the lady and man having the high game handicap and high series handicap for the tournament.

ENTRY APPROVAL: The Tournament Director or committee reserves the right to accept or reject any and all entries and will decide all questions or disputes arising in the tournament and their decisions will be final, subject to the approval of USBC.

UNSCHEDULED TERMINATION: Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or other emergency causes related thereto or there from, fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other reasons beyond the control of the management shall cause the foregoing prize schedules to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants having bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of unscheduled termination.

CELL PHONES/PAGERS: Cell phones and paging devices will not be allowed to ring during tournament play. It is required to either turn the electronic devices to a non-audible mode or turn them off completely during tournament play.

DRESS CODE: Proper attire is required. NO SHORT-SHORTS, NO TANK TOPS, NO HATS.

RETURNED CHECKS: **There will be a service charge of \$30.00 for all returned checks. This charge will be paid before bowling.**

REISSUED CHECKS: If a prize check has to be reissued, a re-issue fee will be subtracted from the new check.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Are responsible for informing all teammates to be at lanes one (1) hour before assigned squad time, making sure participants are aware of tournament rules and bowling etiquette.
